### CRASH WITH ENTRAPMENT

**Anderson Township, January 19, 2013** – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports a crash involving an overturned vehicle on Heatherhill Boulevard on Saturday, January 19, 2013 at 3:45 p.m.

A 1995 Toyota Camry being operated by Philip Lin, age 74, of Anderson Township, was traveling north on Heatherhill Boulevard. Mr. Lin stated that he fell asleep while driving his vehicle. Mr. Lin's vehicle left the roadway and struck a mailbox at 2215 Heatherhill Boulevard. Mr. Lin's vehicle continued off the roadway, struck an electric transformer and then rolled onto its top. Witnesses at the scene broke a window to free Mr. Lin.

Mr. Lin was not injured in the crash.

Due to the transformer being struck, power to a few houses was lost. Duke Energy responded to the scene. It is unknown how long the repairs will take.

Mr. Lin was wearing a seatbelt.

Drugs and/or alcohol were not a factor in this crash.

Mr. Lin was cited for Failure to Maintain Reasonable Control of his vehicle, ORC 4511.202.
