### FATAL MOTORCYCLE CRASH IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

**Anderson Township, January 26, 2013** – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports fatal motorcycle crash which occurred on Kellogg Avenue at Old Kellogg Road, Anderson Township, Saturday, January 26, 2013, at 8:38 p.m.

A 2012 Harley Davidson operated by Tracy Bowling, male, age 37, of Cincinnati, Ohio, was traveling westbound on Kellogg Avenue approaching Old Kellogg Road. Mr. Bowling failed to negotiate a slight left hand curve causing his motorcycle to travel off the right side of the roadway and strike a guardrail. The motorcycle then went down on its left side and traveled across both lanes of Kellogg Avenue. It came to rest along the eastbound shoulder. Mr. Bowling was ejected when the motorcycle struck the guardrail.

Mr. Bowling was transported to University Hospital by the Anderson Township Fire Department. He was pronounced dead at 10:23 p.m.

Mr. Bowling was not wearing a helmet.

Alcohol is believed to have been a factor in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
