PEDESTRIAN STRUCK IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

ANDERSON TOWNSHIP, 04/25/2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports On April 25, 2013 at approximately 1725hrs a serious injury auto crash occurred, involving a pedestrian being struck in the intersection of S.R.-125 (Beechmont Ave) and King Louis Court, in Anderson Township. A 2008 ford f-250 operated by Mr. Brian A. Burger, 39 yoa, of Anderson Township, was attempting to make a right turn onto westbound S.R.-125, from the business driveway of Pinnacle Plaza located in the 7900 block of S.R.-125. As Mr. Burger proceeded to make his right turn the front portion of his vehicle struck Mr. Guy K. Wentzel ,53 yoa, of Anderson Township, a pedestrian, who was walking eastbound across the business driveway at the intersection during the collision Mr. Wentzel was knocked to the asphalt pavement, where he sustained serious injuries . Mr. Wentzel was transported to University Hospital by U.C. AirCare for treatment of his injuries, where he remains in critical condition.

The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
