SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE FOUND

Colerain Township, June 22, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, and Chief Daniel P Meloy, Colerain Township Police Department, reports deputies from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and officers from the Colerain Township Police Department were dispatched to 3394 Amberway in Colerain Township to investigate a suspicious package which was left on the side of a shed next to the residence.

Responding units observed the package which resembled a small black suitcase with the letters "ALA" written across the top, and requested the Hamilton County Sheriff's Hazardous Device Unit to respond and investigate.

Members of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Hazardous Device Unit (Bomb Squad) responded and were able to determine that the package did not contain dangerous materials.
