COLERAIN MAN ARRESTED FOR MURDER

Colerain Township, March 9, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, and Chief Daniel P. Meloy, Colerain Township Police Department, report the arrest of Geordan R. Calhoun for the murder of Jordan Smith that occurred at 2911 Jonrose Avenue on March 9, 2013.

On March 9, 2013 at 3:51 a.m., patrol units were dispatched to trouble run shots fired at 2911 Jonrose Avenue. Once police units arrived, they found the victim, Jordan Smith, male black, age 21, deceased and Geordan R. Calhoun suffering from a gun shot wound to his right arm. After an extensive investigation by the detectives from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and the Colerain Township Police Department, Geordan R. Calhoun has been arrested and charged with the death of Jordan Smith.

Geordan R. Calhoun, male black, age 24, has been officially charged with Weapons Under Disability, ORC 2923.13, a felony of the 3rd degree; Trafficking in Drugs, ORC 2925.03, a felony of the 3rd degree; and, Murder, ORC 2903.02, a felony of the 1st degree.

Geordan R. Calhoun has been transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center to await arraignment.
