AGGRAVATED ROBBERY IN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

Columbia Township, April 23, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports an Aggravated Robbery that occurred in the 8300 block of Wooster Pike.

At approximately 11:40 p.m., three black, male suspects entered the victim's apartment, one armed with an unknown type of handgun and one with a knife. The suspects ordered the two victims to the ground striking one of the victims in the head with the handgun. The suspects took cash, a laptop computer and a cell phone and exited the residence in an unknown direction. Sheriff's Deputies responded to the scene but were unable to locate the suspects.

No further description of the suspects or weapons could be given by the victims.

The victim who was struck was treated and released by University Hospital for minor head injuries.
