AGGRAVATED ROBBERY IN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

Columbia Township, , June 13,2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports an Aggravated Robbery at the Dollar Tree located at 5245 Ridge Road in Columbia Township.

At approximately 10:55 p.m., two suspects approached three store employees as they were locking up the business, displayed handguns and ordered the employees back into the business. Once inside the suspects ordered the employees into the office and demanded money. The employees complied and the suspects left the business with an undetermined amount of U.S. Currency. No one was injured during the robbery.

Suspect #1 is described as a black, male in his mid 20's wearing a black hoodie and blue jeans carrying a black handgun.

Suspect #2 is described as a black, male in his mid 20's wearing a light grey hoodie, blue jeans and carrying a silver handgun.

Both were seen leaving in a white sedan, possibly a Buick Regal in an unknown direction.
