AGGRAVATED ROBBERY IN GREEN TOWNSHIP

Green Township, March 4, 2013- – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and Chief Bart West, Green Township Police Department reports an Aggravated Robbery which occurred at the Four Seasons Car Wash, located at 4536 Bridgetown Road in Green Township.

At approximately 2:40 p.m. the female victim was cleaning her vehicle at the Four Seasons Car Wash when a male white suspect entered her vehicle, implied to her that he had a handgun, and demanded that she drive to an ATM. After driving the suspect to an ATM and withdrawing U.S. currency per his demand, the suspect ordered the victim to drive him to the area of Belden Court and Werk Roads in the City of Cincinnati where he exited the vehicle and fled on foot. Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies as well as Green Township and Cincinnati Police responded to the area of Belden Court and Werk Roads after the victim called 911. A Cincinnati Police K-9 unit was utilized in an attempt to locate the suspect but was unsuccessful.

The suspect is described as a male white in his late teens to early twenties, approximately 5'09", with a long skinny nose and no facial hair, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt.
