BOB EVANS ROBBERY - MONFORT HEIGHTS

Green Township, 3/26/2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and Chief Bart West, Green Township Police Department reports that an aggravated robbery occurred at the Bob Evans Restaurant located at 5245 North Bend Rd. in Monfort Heights.

At 10:43pm, officers responded to Bob Evans to investigate the robbery after a call was received stating that two male black suspects had entered the closed restaurant while one of the employees was taking out the trash. Once inside, the suspects tied up the employees and placed them on the floor in the kitchen area. The suspects were both armed with guns and were able to flee the scene in an unknown direction with an undetermined amount of cash. There were no injuries during the incident. A Green Twp. K-9 responded to the scene and conducted a track with unsuccessful results.

The suspects were described as follows:

#1 - M/B 6'0", slightly overweight, wearing a black suit and purple tie

#2 - M/B 5'6", very thin, wearing a white hoodie with a blue bandana covering his face, tan jeans with a studded belt and tan work boots.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff/Green Twp. Police Investigative Unit. Anyone with information is asked to contact the police or call Crimestoppers at 352-3040.
