GARBAGE TRUCK INTO HOUSE

Green Township, April 22, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and Chief Bart West, Green Township Police, report at 9:19 a.m., a 2007 Mack overhead garbage truck owned by CSI Waste Removal was traveling westbound on Boomer Road. As the truck began to descend the grade in the roadway, the driver was unable to slow the truck down enough to negotiate the bend onto Reemelin Road. The truck crossed over Reemelin Road where it struck a utility pole and sheared it off at the ground. The truck then continued into the driveway for 5801 Reemelin Road. The truck struck and entered into the home causing significant structural damage. The homeowner, Patricia Grow F/57, was home and was temporarily trapped by the truck and debris. She was extricated by Green Township Fire Department with no injuries reported. The truck operator, Michael Schneider M/33 of Villa Hills, KY, was extricated from the vehicle with no reported injuries. Mr. Schneider was believed to be wearing his safety restraint and drugs and/or alcohol are not believed to be factors in the crash. Mr. Schneider was cited for Failing To Maintain Reasonable Control Of His Vehicle (4511.202 O.R.C.).
