CONCEALED CARRY LICENSE TRAINING

Hamilton County, November 26, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports that the Sheriff's Office will begin offering training classes for Ohio residents to obtain their Ohio concealed carry licenses. Classes will be held regularly and will begin soon. The classes meet the state mandated twelve hours of classroom and live fire training. The cost is \$95.00 for the entire class. Participants can bring their own handgun and ammunition. If needed, the Sheriff's Office can supply a handgun and ammunition for an additional fee of \$40.00.

Currently, interested citizens can choose to participate in one of the following two classes:

- Class #1: January 7th and 9th, 5:00 pm - 9:00 pm, and
January 11th from 8:00 am - 12:00 pm (12 hours total traing time)
- Class #2: February 8th from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, and
February 9th from 8:00 am - 12:00 pm (12 hours total traing time).
