SHOTS FIRED

Harrison Township , January 1, 2014 – Chief Deputy Mark A. Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports that Deputies were dispatched to 11003 Carolina Trace in Harrison Township at 0447 hours for shots fired. Suspect William Ellis male 65 while intoxicated discharged a firearm while inside of his residence. Mr. Ellis was in the basement when the weapon was discharged and there were four adults upstairs.

No one was injured as a result of the weapon being fired.

The Hamilton County Special Response Team was activated.

William Ellis was taken into custody without further incident. He was charged with Inducing Panic 2917.31 a misdemeanor of the first degree and Using Weapons While Intoxicated 2923.15 a misdemeanor of the first degree.

William Ellis was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center
