SHOOTING IN LINCOLN HEIGHTS

Village of Lincoln Heights , August 30, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports that at 1251 P.M. a shooting occurred in the 900 block of Adams Street in the Village of Lincoln Heights.

At approximately 12:51 P.M. the Lincoln Heights Police Department responded for the report of shots fired in the 900 block of Adams Street. Officers responded to the scene and discovered a white Honda Accord that had multiple bullet holes. During the investigation a male two years of age was found suffering from a gun shot wound to the leg. There were two additional males in the white Honda Accord, a male driver who was not injured and an unknown male who left the scene prior to the Lincoln Heights Police Department arriving on scene.

The Village of Lincoln Heights Police Department, Chief Conroy Chance, requested that the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office assist them in the investigation.

The male 2 years of age was transported to Childrens Hospital, treated and released.

The shooting incident on Adams Street remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section.
