PURSUIT ENDS WITH CRASH AND ARREST

City of Montgomery, July 8, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark A. Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports a motor vehicle pursuit, which ended in a (3) vehicle crash on Remington Road at Montgomery Road, in the City of Montgomery on Monday, July 08, 2013 at 11:11 a.m.

At approximately 11:04 a.m. a Sheriff's Deputy in a marked patrol vehicle, which was equipped with the Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) system received an alert for a stolen license plate. The Deputy observed a 1998 Honda Accord, white in color, which displaying the reported stolen license plate traveling on Lovelland-Madeira Road in Symmes Township. The Deputy attempted to stop the vehicle. The operator of the Honda failed to comply with the Deputy's signal to stop and entered onto eastbound Interstate 275. At this point, the Deputy initiated a traffic pursuit. The Honda continued eastbound Interstate 275 at a high rate of speed before exited onto southbound Wards Corner Road. The pursuit continued westbound on State Route 126 and then onto Remington Road. The Deputy lost sight of the vehicle on Remington Road east of Main Street. As the Deputy approached the intersection of Remington Road at Montgomery Road it was observed that the suspect vehicle was involved in a motor vehicle collision with two additional vehicles.

The two additional vehicles involved in the collision were a 2006 Honda Accord, operated by Wayne Taylor, age 70 Cincinnati, Ohio and a 2008 BMW 535, operated by Martin Clark, age 64 Cincinnati, Ohio. Neither Mr. Taylor or Taylor were injured during this event.

The front seat passenger in the 2006 Honda, Mary Taylor, age 69 Cincinnati, Ohio was treated at the scene by the City of Montgomery Fire Department for a minor arm injury

The pursuit lasted 7 minutes in duration and covered 7.1 miles. The pursuit reached speeds of 85 mph, while on the Interstate.

Arrested were Natasha Wilson, age 26 of Blanchester, Ohio; driver of the stolen car, and Steven Mages, age 24 of Blanchester, Ohio; front seat passenger in the stolen car. Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies charged Ms. Wilson with (2) counts of Receiving Stolen Property, 2913.51; Failure to Comply, 2912.331(b) and Drug Abuse Instruments, 2925.12 O.R.C and (5) outstanding warrants. She was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center to await arraignment.

Mr. Mages was arrested on an outstanding felony warrant from Clermont County.

Mr. Mages was transported to University Hospital by the Loveland-Symmes Fire Department for back pain. Upon his release he will be turned over to the Clermont County Sheriff's Office
