SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE FOUND

North Bend, Ohio, May 4, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports deputies from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to Taylor High School located at 36 E. Harrison Ave in the village of North Bend, Ohio to investigate a suspicious package which was left on a sidewalk at the front entrance to the school.

Responding units observed the package which resembled a large gift box on the front sidewalk and requested the Hazardous Device Unit to respond to investigate.

Members of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Hazardous Device Unit (Bomb Squad) responded and were able to determine that the package was an empty box which may have been left behind from the previous evenings school function.
