SILVERTON SHOOTING

City of Silverton, October 4, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and Chief Bruce Molett, Silverton Police Department, reports that Officers were dispatched to 6721 Montgomery Road, the H.D. Bean Café at 1:54 a.m., for the report of shots fired. Responding Officers located a crime scene and learned that two victims had arrived at local hospitals for treatment of gun shot wounds.

Victim #1 is identified as Neldon Terry, male 33 years of age. Gun shot would to the arm

Victim #2 is identified as Jeron Wilson, male 21 years of age. Gun shot wound to the neck.

Both victims are expected to recover from their injuries.

The Silverton Police Department and the Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigative Section are continuing to follow up on leads relating to this case. Anyone with information is asked to contact (513) 851-6000 or Crime Stoppers at (513) 352-3040.

An arrest has been made in this case. Charged with Felonious Assault (two counts), Weapons Under Disability and Improperly Discharging a Weapon into a Habitation is Austin R. Tiernan of 5500 Montgomery Road. Mr. Tiernan was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center to await arraignment.
