AGGRAVATED BURGLARY

Sycamore Township, August 20, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark A. Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports an aggravated burglary which occurred at 7691 Camner Ave in Sycamore Township at about 1 PM today.

The lone occupant of the residence, a 16 year old, reports that he was awakened by 3 subjects who entered his residence and demanded money from him before they assaulted him and fled through a rear door. The 16 year old sustained minor injuries but refused medical treatment at the scene.

The suspects are described as 2 male black subjects in their late teens wearing jeans and white hoodies and 1 male black subject in his late teens wearing a black hoodie.

The offense is being investigated by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division.
