### VERIZON STORE BURGLARIZED IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP

**Sycamore Township, Ohio, May 6, 2013** – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports a Breaking and Entering that occurred at the Verizon store in Sycamore Township on May 6, 2013.

At approximately 3:42 A.M., Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to an intrusion alarm at the Verizon store at 7790 Montgomery Road. The first units at the scene discovered a large rock had been through through the front glass door, shattering the glass. Video footage showed three male blacks with their heads covered, two wearing khaki pants and black jackets and one wearing a grey sweatshirt, entering the business, removing merchandise from display cases and leaving the store. Taken in the offense were an unknown number of cell phones and tablets.

This incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Section. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Sheriff's Patrol at 825-1500 or Crime Stoppers at 352-3040.
