AGGRAVATED ROBBERY OF UNITED DAIRY FARMERS IN SYMMES TWP

Symmes Township, February 16, 2013 – Chief Deputy Mark Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports an aggravated robbery at the United Dairy Farmers store located at 12114 Mason Montgomery Road, Symmes Township.

At 12:48 a.m., February 16, 2013, officers were dispatched to the United Dairy Farmers store located at 12114 Mason Montgomery Road for an aggravated robbery that had just occurred. Two male black suspects wearing masks armed with semi-automatic handguns entered the store and demanded money. The suspects ordered the employees to lie down on the floor. Both suspects then exited through the rear door and fled on foot northbound on Governors Way with an undetermined amount of U.S. Currency in a plastic bag. There were no injuries as a result of this incident.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Canine Unit tracked the suspects and was met with negative results.

Suspect #1 is described as male black, 6'0", thin build, gray hooded sweat shirt with white strips, dark jean pants and gray/white shoes, wearing a ski mask on half of his face armed with a silver semi-automatic handgun.

Suspect #2 is described as male black, 5'10", green and brown jacket, red hooded sweat shirt underneath, dark pants, black shoes, wearing a mask and armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.
