### JUVENILE STRUCK BY VEHICLE IN SYMMES TOWNSHIP

**Symmes Township, November , 2013** – Chief Deputy Mark A. Schoonover, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, reports an injury auto crash that occurred in the 9200 block of Kemper Grove Lane, at 12:48 p.m., on Saturday, November , 2013.

A 2008 Audi Q7, operated by Christine Kline, F/38, of Loveland, Ohio was traveling northbound in the 9200 block of Kemper Grove Lane. As Mrs. Kline attempted to turn into a residence, her vehicle struck a juvenile, M/7, of Loveland, Ohio. The juvenile was riding on a Razor 3-wheel bike, and was traveling southbound on Kemper Grove Lane.

The male juvenile was injured and trapped beneath the vehicle for a short time. He was freed by the Loveland-Symmes fire department. The juvenile was then flown to Cincinnati's Children's Hospital, by Aircare. The juvenile is currently listed in stable condition. Mrs. Kline was not injured in the crash.

Alcohol and/or drugs of abuse are not factors in this crash. The juvenile was not wearing any safety equipment at the time of the crash, however Mrs. Kline was wearing her safety restraint device at the time of the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Unit.
