AGGRAVATED ROBBERY AT KEY BANK

Anderson Township, February 4, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an aggravated robbery that occurred on February 4, 2014 at 2:33pm at the Key Bank located at 8601 Beechmont Avenue. The suspect entered the bank and gave the teller a note. The note stated he was armed with a weapon and demanded cash from the bank teller. The suspect then fled the bank on foot with an unknown amount of U.S. currency. No injuries were reported. Sheriff's deputies responded to scene and a Sharonville K-9 unit tracked eastbound, but the suspect was not located. The suspect is described as a male white possibly in his late 30's, early 40's, clean shaven, approximately 6'0" tall, 200 pounds, wearing a dark colored, Nike jacket over a white shirt, blue jeans and a light colored ball cap with a possible palm tree logo on the front.
