HOMICIDE SUSPECT FLEES FROM TRAFFIC STOP

Columbia Township, Ohio, March 10, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports on March 10, 2014 at approximately 1:00 AM, a Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputy stopped a white 2000 Buick Regal on the Norwood Lateral (SR-562) near Ridge Avenue for a traffic violation. During the course of the stop the rear seat passenger exited the vehicle and fled on foot through a wooded area along I-71. The deputy gave chase but lost the subject after a brief foot pursuit. The subject was identified as Terrence D. Brown who is wanted for murder and robbery out of Nashville, Tennessee. An extensive search by Sheriff's and Cincinnati Police K-9 units as well as the Sheriff's helicopter was unsuccessful. The other two occupants of the vehicle were released.

Terrence D. Brown is described as a Black Male 25 years of age 6'01" 150 pounds and was last seen wearing dark pants and a camouflage jacket. He should be considered armed and dangerous.
