## VEHICLE PURSUIT ENDS IN CRASH

**Columbia Township, Ohio, March 19, 2014** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit initiated by a Sheriff's Columbia Township unit that ended with a crash in the City of Cincinnati on March 19, 2014.

At approximately 12:01 A.M. a Sheriff's Deputy attempted to stop a 2006 Acura RL, operated by Keion L. Robinson, M/22 from Cincinnati, Ohio, for a traffic violation at Montgomery Road at Woodford Road in the City of Cincinnati. Robinson refused to stop for the deputy, leading the officer and assisting police agencies, on a lengthy traffic pursuit that traveled on I-71 in addition to main roadways through several Cincinnati neighborhoods. Robinson eventually lost control of his vehicle in the 3200 block of Burnet Avenue, crashing into a decorative brick retaining wall in front of 3230 Burnet Avenue. Robinson, in addition to two other occupants in the car, including a 17 year old female juvenile, exited the vehicle and attempted to flee on foot. All occupants were quickly apprehended by pursuing and responding officers. A .380 caliber semi-auto pistol was recovered from Robinson's person. A fourth occupant remained in the vehicle. The City of Cincinnati Police Department is conducting the crash investigation and will be filing charges related to the accident.

Keion L. Robinson is being charged with Felony Fleeing and Eluding, a felony of the 5<sup>th</sup> degree, Carrying Concealed Weapons, a felony of the 4<sup>th</sup> degree, Endangering Children, a misdemeanor of the 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Obstructing Official Business, a misdemeanor of the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Operating a Motor Vehicle without a Valid Driver's License, a misdemeanor of the 1<sup>st</sup> degree and Improper Display, a minor misdemeanor. He was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center pending arraignment. The female juvenile, who had an outstanding warrant for runaway, was charged with Obstructing Official Business, a misdemeanor of the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, and transported to the Hamilton County Juvenile Detention Facility. A third passenger, Asia S. Palmer, F/24 from Cincinnati, Ohio, was cited for Obstructing Official Business, a misdemeanor of the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree. The fourth passenger was released without any charges being filed.
