Update to Pedestrian Struck

ANDERSON TOWNSHIP, February 7, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a crash involving a pedestrian struck on Beechmont Avenue at Salem Rd. in Anderson Township on February 07, 2014 at 8:11 A.M.

A 2013 Toyota Corolla, operated by Karin Dietz, age 29 of Cincinnati, Ohio, was traveling east on Beechmont Avenue in the right lane approaching the intersection of Salem Rd. A pedestrian, Noah Goertemiller, age 23 of Cincinnati, Ohio, was crossing Beechmont Ave from Salem Rd. at the crosswalk. Mr. Goertemiller was struck by the Toyota and did sustain injuries.

Noah Goertemiller was transported to University Hospital by Anderson Township Fire Dept where he is listed in stable condition. Karen Dietz was transported to Anderson Mercy by Anderson Township Fire Dept for treatment of minor injuries.

Alcohol and drugs were not a factor in the crash. This crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Traffic Safety Unit. Any witnesses to this incident are asked to contact the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit at (513) 825-1500.
