OFFICER INJURED DURING ARREST

Silverton, April 24th, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that Patrol Officer John Williamson received minor injury as a result of taking a subject into custody.

Officer Williamson observed a suspicious subject near the intersection of Hampton and Montgomery Road in the City of Silverton at 12:13 AM. During his investigation Officer Williamson discovered that the subject, Ryan Casey of Silverton, had open felony warrants.

When Officer Williamson attempted to place Casey into custody, Casey fled and a struggle ensued. Casey was taken into custody with the assistance of other departments. Officer Williamson received minor injuries and was transported to Jewish Hospital for treatment and released. Casey was charged with resisting arrest and possession of an open container of an alcoholic beverage in addition to his warrants.
