BANK ROBBERY-WHITEWATER TOWNSHIP

Whitewater Township, June 24, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the robbery of the Miami Savings and Loan located at 8008 Ferry Street in Whitewater Township on June 24th at approximately 1:36 pm.

A male white subject in his twenties, wearing a white long sleeve button down shirt, blue jeans, with brown hair and moustache entered the bank and demanded money from the victim teller. The subject implied that he had a gun, but none was seen. After receiving an undetermined amount of US Currency, the subject fled the bank in a southerly direction on foot. Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies as well as neighboring jurisdictions responded to the scene and secured a perimeter. The area was searched by K-9 and Helicopter, but the subject was able to avoid immediate capture.

The Criminal Investigative Section learned that the subject was in another nearby bank just prior to the robbery and obtained security video from both locations.

There were several employees in the bank at the time of this robbery, but no one was injured in this offense.
