Critical Missing Person

Miami Township, June 21, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that at 2:12 p.m. on June 21st 2014, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 7000 block of Wesselman Rd. in Miami Twp. for a report of a missing person. When Deputies arrived, they learned that an individual identified as Paul Bramlage was missing and had not been seen or heard from in nearly a month. Deputies searched the area near Mr. Bramlage's residence and were unable to locate him.

Paul Bramlage is described as a male white, 54 years of age 6'2" tall and approximately 200 Lbs. Mr. Bramlage has red/grey hair and hazel eyes. Mr. Bramlage is prescribed medication that he does not have with him. There is no information available at this time as to what clothing Mr. Bramlage was last wearing or any possible destination.

UPDATE

Hamilton County, June 26, 2014 – At approximately 9:15 a.m. this morning the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office located Cory Hall, Male, White, age 38, in Miami Township (Hamilton Co., OH) on unrelated traffic warrants.

Mr. Hall, the nephew of Paul Bramlage (missing person referenced above) was brought in for questioning by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section reference his uncle's whereabouts. As a result of the interview, Mr. Hall led detectives to the location of the deceased body of Mr. Bramlage located in Dearborn County, Indiana.

Based on the interview and evidence collected, Cory Hall has been charged with one count of Murder and one count of Abuse of a Corpse.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Section, the Hamilton County Coroner, and the Dearborn County (IN) Sheriff's Office.
