AUTOMOBILE CRASH WITH ENTRAPMENT

Whitewater Township, 7/21/2014, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a single vehicle crash with entrapment at 6689 Kilby Road.

At 10:36 a.m., a 1999 GMC Envoy was traveling southbound on Kilby Road. The vehicle was being operated by Catherine Slusher (Female 56 from Harrison, Ohio). As Mrs. Slusher exited a curve in the roadway, her vehicle drifted off the right side of the roadway. The vehicle then went airborne after striking a driveway apron. Mrs. Slusher's vehicle finally came to rest after it struck a utility pole and a parked boat and trailer. Whitewater Township and City of Harrison Fire and EMS responded and extracted Mrs. Slusher, who had become entrapped, from her vehicle. She was flown by University Air Care to University Hospital where she is listed in stable condition.

At the time of the crash, Mrs. Slusher was not wearing her safety belt nor did the airbags deploy. Alcohol and drugs are not believed to be a factor in the crash.
