MUTIPLE VEHICLE CRASH ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, July 23rd, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a multiple vehicle crash on Five Mile Road at Woodcroft Drive.

On 7/23/14 at 2:27 p.m., a 1997 Toyota Camry was being driven south on Five Mile Road by a seventeen year old female from Cincinnati. As she attempted to turn right onto Woodcroft Drive, her vehicle began to slide on the wet pavement. Her vehicle slid into a 2012 Toyota Camry that was stopped at the stop sign on Woodcroft Drive. That vehicle was being driven by Roger Brummet (M/69/from Cincinnati). After the collision with his vehicle, Mr. Brummet's foot slipped off the brake and onto the gas pedal. Mr. Brummet's vehicle began to travel out into the intersection. A 2002 Pontiac Grand Am, driven by Kimberly Corley (F/48/from Loveland), was traveling southbound on Five Mile Road and was unable to avoid Mr. Brummet's vehicle. Mrs. Corley's vehicle struck the left front portion of Mr. Brummet's Camry causing it to be redirected into the northbound lane of Five Mile Road. A 2006 Isuzu NPR was being operated northbound on Five Mile Road by Timothy Gravina (M/56/from Harrison). Mr Gravina attempted to steer away from Mr. Brummet, but was unsuccessful. The Camry struck the left front of the Isuzu truck and forced it into the guardrail. As Mr. Gravina attempted to regain control of his vehicle, the right front tire caught on the pavement causing it to rollover onto the passenger side.

Anderson Township Fire Department responded and had to cut Mr. Brummet out of his vehicle. He was transported to Mercy Hospital of Anderson where he is listed in stable condition. He was wearing his safety belt and his airbag deployed during the crash. All the other drivers were also wearing their safety belts and there were no other injuries.

The seventeen year old driver was cited for Failing To Maintain Reasonable Control of her vehicle (ORC 4511.202). Drugs and alcohol were not a factor of the crash.
