TRAFFIC PURSUIT

Columbia Township, July 10, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a traffic pursuit that began in the 3100 block of Losantiville Road, in the city of Cincinnati. At approximately 12:15 a.m. Sheriff's Units attempted to make a traffic stop on a silver Dodge Grand Caravan driven by a Fredrick Harris, Male, Black, 46yrs old. Mr. Harris had a female passenger in the vehicle with him and refused to stop. Mr. Harris traveled northwest on Losantiville Road and continued through numerous streets in which he ran several red lights and at times traveled on the wrong side of the road.

The pursuit came to an end in the 5800 block of Kennedy Avenue at which time Mr. Harris fled from the vehicle on foot. The female passenger remained with the vehicle. Following a K9 track, Mr. Harris was located inside of a residence in the 5800 block of Kennedy Avenue. Mr. Harris was taken into custody without further incident and charged with Felony Fleeing and Eluding as well as numerous traffic offenses.
