Inmate Wanted



Hamilton County Justice Center, July 1, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an inmate in the Hamilton County Justice Center is wanted. This evening, inmate Chris Bowden, male black, age 20, left the Justice Center. Mr. Bowden was sentenced to 10 years in the Ohio Department of Corrections for Aggravated Robbery and was awaiting a court appearance. Mr. Bowden should be considered dangerous. Anyone with any information on the whereabouts of Mr. Bowden should contact the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office at 513-825-1500 or Crimestoppers at 513-352-3040.

UPDATE

After an initial investigation it has been determined that inmate Chris Bowden conspired to falsify his identity and was subsequently released from the Justice Center. The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office has issued Escape Warrants for Mr. Bowden's arrest and are actively searching for the suspect. Mr. Bowden was being held at the Justice Center after being convicted of Aggravated Robbery and could potentially be dangerous.
