VEHICLE INTO A BUILDING

Anderson Township, July 01, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a single vehicle crash into a building at 7466 Beechmont Ave. (Weight Watchers) in Anderson Township on Tuesday July 01, 2014 at 12:21 PM.

A 2012 Ford Fusion operated by Minnie Gantzer, age 64, of Cincinnati, Ohio was traveling north through the parking lot of the Anderson Towne Center. Mrs. Gantzer attempted to pull her vehicle into a parking space in front of Weight Watchers. Mrs. Gantzer stepped on the accelerator instead of the brake. The vehicle was driven over the curb and into the store front. While the vehicle was crashing into the store a female customer, Nancy Futrell, age 65, of Cincinnati, Ohio was injured. Mrs. Futrell was transported to University Hospital by Anderson Township EMS for treatment of non-life threatening injuries. Mrs. Gantzer was also transported by Anderson Township EMS to Anderson Mercy for treatment of possible injuries.

A seatbelt was utilized by Mrs. Gantzer. Drugs and / or alcohol are not believed to be a factor. A citation was issued to Mrs. Gantzer for failure to maintain reasonable control, 4511.202 of the Ohio Revised Code.
