Baby Found Deceased

Addyston, Ohio, August 6, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Addyston Police Chief LaCourse report at approximately 6:00 A.M. officers were dispatched to 115 First Avenue, Addyston, Ohio. Addyston Police were first on the scene, along with the Miami Township Fire Squad. First responders found a baby, approximately 7 week old, unresponsive. At the request of the Addyston Police Department the Sheriff's Office responded and is assisting in the investigation. The Miami Township Fire Squad transported the victim to Mercy West Hospital where she was pronounced deceased by the doctor a short time later.

At this time it is believed that alcohol or drugs were not a factor, however the Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section is handling the ongoing investigation along with the Hamilton County Coroner's Office.
