## MOTORCYCLE CRASH WITH INJURY

**Anderson Township, September 8th, 2014** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports on 9/8/14, at approximately 4:56 pm, a 1997 Yamaha motorcycle was being operated westbound on Beechmont Avenue, in the center lane. The operator was identified as Bettina Myers (F/47/from Cincinnati). As Ms. Myers approached the intersection at Five Mile Road, the traffic signal turned from green to yellow. During the rapid slowing, Ms. Myers lost control of the motorcycle causing it to fall over onto its side. When the motorcycle fell over, Ms. Myers struck her head on the asphalt roadway.

Anderson Township Fire Department responded to the scene and transported Ms. Myers to University Hospital for treatment of a head injury. She is listed in stable condition. Ms. Myers was not wearing a helmet at the time of the crash. Drugs and alcohol are not believed to be a factor in the crash.
