DRIVER IDENTIFIED IN FATAL CRASH

Whitewater Township, October 27, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a fatal auto crash near 5255 SR 128. At approximately 5:10 p.m., a silver SUV was traveling southbound on SR 128. The vehicle failed to negotiate a curve in the roadway and drove off the right side. The vehicle then drove into a creek bed where it rolled over onto its top. The vehicle then caught on fire. The driver of the vehicle sustained fatal injuries in the event. His identity is being withheld pending positive identification and family notification.

Seat belt use is unknown due to the severity of the fire. At the time of this release, it is unknown if drugs or alcohol played any part in the crash. The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.

UPDATED

Hamilton County, October 28, 2014 – The driver of the vehicle has been identified as Adam Langdon, Male, 23 years of age, from West Harrison, Indiana. The incident remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
