ARREST IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP SHOOTING

Sycamore Township, November 21, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of a juvenile for Aggravated Robbery/Felonious Assault.

On November 5, 2014, at approximately 5:00 P.M. Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies learned that an individual had been shot in the leg while parked in his car on Taylor Avenue. The victim stated that a male black, approximately 17 years of age, entered his car and demanded money. When the victim hesitated, the suspect shot him one time in the leg. The suspect fled the scene with the victims wallet, cash and cellular phone.

Through the investigation it was determined that this incident was linked to similar offenses comitted in the Colerain Township area. Colerain Township Police Detectives and the Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigative Section worked this case cooperatively which resulted in the arrest of the suspect.

On November 21, 2014 a male juvenile, age 15, of Pippin Road in Colerain Township was arrested and taken into custody. This subject was transported to the Hamilton County Juvenile Detention Center to await arraignment. This juvenile was charged with one count of Felonious Assault and one count of Aggravated Robbery.
