## PERSON SHOT IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP

**Sycamore Township, Ohio, November 5, 2014** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a shooting that occurred in Sycamore Township on November 5, 2014.

At approximately 5:00 P.M., the victim, Patrick Rudolph, 18 years old from Deer Park, Ohio, was sitting in his vehicle as it was parked in the 4500 block of Taylor Avenue in Sycamore Township. A male black described as 17-19 years old, dark skinned, short hair, approximately 6 feet tall with a slender build, wearing a red sweater and armed with a small dark revolver, opened the passenger door and demanded Rudolph's money. At that point, the suspect shot Rudolph in the right knee, opened the glovebox removing his wallet and then took his cell phone before fleeing on foot in an easterly direction. The suspect may have entered a small gray vehicle, possibly a Ford Focus. Rudolph drove to his residence after the shooting and was driven by a family member to Bethesda North Hospital, where he was treated and released.

This incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Sheriff's Patrol at 825-1500 or Crime Stoppers at 352-3040.
