OVERTURNED SEMI TRACTOR TRAILER

ANDERSON TOWNSHIP, December 03, 2014 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a semi tractor trailer crash in Anderson Township earlier this morning.

On December 03, 2014, at 6:36 A.M., a 1996 Freightliner, being operated by Luckie Webb, age 64, of Washington Court House, Ohio, overturned in the entrance to Cargill. Cargill is a food processing company located at 6761 Kellogg Ave. Mr. Webb was traveling west on Kellogg Ave and began turning left into Cargill. The rear portion of Mr. Webb's trailer which was loaded with soybeans, traveled off the roadway and into a deep ditch. This caused the trailer to overturn. As the trailer overturned so did the tractor. Mr. Webb was able to climb out of the semi on his own. Mr. Webb sustained minor injuries to his hands and face. Anderson Township Fire department responded and treated Mr. Webb at the scene.

Alcohol and drugs were not a factor. Mr. Webb was wearing a seatbelt. No citation was issued.
