AGGRAVATED ROBBERY OF MARATHON GAS STATION

Whitewater Township, January 14, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the Aggravated Robbery of the Marathon gas station located at 6383 State Route 128. At approximately 9:10 pm, the suspect entered the store and displayed a black shotgun. The suspect ordered the cashier to give him the money from the register. After the cashier complied, the suspect fled the store with an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. There was one customer in the store at the time but no one was injured during the offense.

The suspect is described as a tall male white, slender build with a black ski mask covering his face. He was wearing a black jacket, blue jeans and black gloves.

This incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Section.
