HOMICIDE IN LINCOLN HEIGHTS

Lincoln Heights, Ohio, January 29, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a shooting that resulted in a homicide in Lincoln Heights that occurred on January 29, 2015.

At approximately 3:56 P.M., Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a person shot in the 600 block of Van Buren Avenue. The victim, an eighteen year old male black, was found in the street in front of 690 Van Buren Avenue, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to University Hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries a short time later. A possible suspect, only described as a male black dressed in all brown, was last seen running east on Van Buren Avenue through a wooded area. A K-9 track for the suspect was unsuccessful.

The name of the victim is being withheld pending notification of kin.

This incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Section. Anyone with information is requested to contact the Sheriff's Patrol at 825-1500, the Criminal Investigation Section at 851-6000, or Crime Stoppers at 352-3040.
