## AGGRAVATED ROBBERY AT TACO BELL, LINCOLN HEIGHTS

**Village of Lincoln Heights, February 22, 2015** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery that occurred at 9:42 P.M. at the Taco Bell located at 9557 Mangham Drive. Three suspects entered the business, all brandishing handguns. One of the suspects held the employee at gunpoint while the other two suspects went behind the counter and took a cash drawer from the register. A second employee fled the business, by means of a rear door, when he realized the store was being robbed. All three subjects then fled the business on foot in a southbound direction. A canine track was conducted with negative results. The suspects took an undetermined amount of currency. There were no customers in the business at the time of the incident and neither employee was injured.

All three suspects are described as male, black, between 5'8" and 5'11", with slender builds, in their teens to early twenties. All three suspects were wearing dark colored pants with hoodies and facial coverings. The first suspect had a hoodie which was grey in color, the other two suspects had hoodies which were black in color.
