## BOMB THREAT AT MASERATI DEALERSHIP IN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

**Columbia Township, February 12, 2015** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a bomb threat was received at the Maserati Dealership, located at 4113 Plainville Road in Columbia Township on February 12, 2015.

At approximately 5:30 P.M., Cincinnati Police contacted the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and stated that an unknown caller contacted the City of Cincinnati Communications Center advising that three bombs had been placed in vehicles at the Maserati Dealership. Sheriff's Units responded to the scene and closed Plainville Road between Bramble and Cambridge. The Dollar General Store, located at 4109 Plainville Road, was also vacated. A Hamilton County Sheriff's Bomb K-9 responded and searched the scene with negative results. The roadways and the business were closed for approximately two hours while the search was being conducted.
