ESCAPED INMATE

Cincinnati, February 5, 2015, – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the escape of Charles Martin M/W/31, from the Woodburn Turning Point facility located at 2605 Woodburn Avenue Cincinnati, Ohio 45206. At approximately 6:34 pm., Inmate Martin escaped the facility wearing a red and white striped jail uniform last seen walking in the southeastern direction towards William Howard Taft. Inmate Martin is incarcerated for disorderly conduct, attempt endangered child neglect, and possession of drug abuse instruments.

UPDATE

Escaped inmate was taken into custody in the 5200 block of Beechmont Avenue by Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies at 9:46 pm. Charles Martin was subsequently transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center, charged with Escape.
