MANUFACTURE OF METHAMPHETAMINE, CHILD ENDANGERMENT IN MIAMI TOWNSHIP

Miami Township, March 24, 2015, – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports at approximately 7:00 p.m., deputies were dispatched to 4222 East Miami River Road to meet a representative with Childrens Services reference removing children from this residence and possible drugs inside. Upon arrival, deputies observed hazardous chemicals used to manufacture methamphetamine and observed three children, ages four, nine, and twelve inside the residence. At this time the residence was evacuated.

Members of the Regional Narcotics Unit (RENU) responded to 4222 East Miami River Road to remove the hazardous chemicals from inside the residence.

Miami Township EMS responded to evaluate the occupants of the residence. No injuries reported at this time

The Mother of the three children, identified as Diana Sunderhaus, female white, 33 years of age, residing at 4222 East Miami River Road, was arrested on scene, and charged with three counts of Endangering Children 2919.22 ORC a felony of the third degree and the illegal assembly or possession of chemicals for manufacturing drugs 2925.041, a felony of the second degree

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff 's Office/Regional Narcotics Unit .
