AGGRAVATED ROBBERY IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP

Sycamore Township, Ohio, March 5 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery that occurred at the Shell Gas Station, 8051 Montgomery Rd, on March 5th 2015.

At 12:32 A.M. Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the Shell Gas Station for the report of a robbery which just occurred. At 12:30 A.M. a suspect described as a male white, average height and build, wearing a black ski mask, black jacket, blue jeans, black gloves and black and white gym shoes, entered the store and completed a purchase. Once the cash drawer was open, the male suspected implied that he had a gun in his coat pocket and demanded money from the register. The store clerk handed the suspect the cash drawer and the suspect removed an undetermined amount of US currency and fled the store on foot in a northbound direction. A K-9 track was conducted however the suspect was not located. There were no customers in the business at the time and the employee was not hurt during this incident.
