MANUFACTURE OF METHAMPHETAMINE IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, May 21, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports at approximately 7:00 a.m. deputies received information about a subject wanted on a felony sleeping in a shed located at 7885 YMCA Road. Upon arrival, deputies observed what appeared to be a one pot meth lab near the rear of the shed.

Regional Enforcement Narcotics Unit (RENU) agents responded to the residence above to confirm and remove the hazardous chemicals from the rear of the property. During the investigation other components to manufacture methamphetamine was also recovered.

The subject, identified as Stephanie King, female white, 46 years of age, was wanted on felony probation violation warrants and misdemeanor-capias for obstructing official business was arrested on the scene. She was also charged with illegal manufacture of drugs (2925.04, a felony of the second degree) and illegal assembly or possession of chemicals for manufacturing drugs (2925.041, a felony of the third degree).

A second individual, Duke Haag, male white, 40 years of age, was also arrested on scene and charged with the illegal assembly or possession of chemicals for manufacturing drugs (2925.041, a felony of the third degree).

No injuries reported.

This incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Regional Enforcement Narcotics Unit.
