PERSON SHOT

Village of Silverton, June 10, 2015, – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports at approximately 6:01 p.m., deputies responded to 6000 block of West Fordham Place, Village of Silverton, for a person shot. Upon arrival, deputies located the victim, a Jamie L. Mincy, F/B/21, with a gunshot wound to her upper chest area. The victim was transported to UC hospital by ambulance. A Clarese Tolder, F/B/30, was taken into custody at the scene.

An argument had occurred between Ms. Mincy and Ms. Tolder that escalated into a physical confrontation. Ms. Tolder then produced a handgun and fired one shot striking Ms. Mincy in the chest. Ms. Mincy was last reported to be in stable condition. Ms. Tolder was arrested and charged with Felonious Assault.
