TWO VEHICLE CRASH IN THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

Village of Addyston, July, 26th 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a two vehicle crash that occurred at the intersection of U.S. 50 and Dining Lane in the Village of Addyston on Sunday July 26, 2015 at 3:08 pm.

A 1960 Chevrolet Impala operated by Gilbert Russell, male, age 69 of Cincinnati, Ohio was traveling westbound on U.S. 50 approaching Dining Lane. A 2014 Nissan operated by Jerry Schnell, male, age 78 of Cincinnati, Ohio was traveling southbound on Dining Lane. Mr. Schnell made a left turn onto eastbound U.S. 50 and failed to observe Mr. Russell approaching the intersection. Mr. Schnell's vehicle entered into the path of Mr. Russell's vehicle, causing the two vehicles to collide.

Mr. Russell's wife, Sandra Russell, was a passenger in Mr. Russell's vehicle at the time of the crash. Mrs. Russell was transported to University Hospital by Miami Township Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

Mr. Russell was transported to University Hospital by Miami Township Fire Department where he is listed in critical condition.

A juvenile passenger in Mr. Russell's vehicle was transported to Children's Hospital by Delhi Township Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

Mr. Schnell was transported to Mercy West Hospital by Whitewater Township Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

Mr. Russell's vehicle was not equipped with safety restraints.

Mr. Schnell was utilizing his safety restraint at the time of crash.

Alcohol, drugs and speed are not believed to be factors in the crash. The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
