FATAL TRAFFIC CRASH ON I.R. 275 IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, August 21, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a fatal traffic crash which occurred on I.R. 275 at milepost 68.0 (east of the Five Mile Road exit) in Anderson Township on August 21, 2015 at 7:31 p.m.

A 2006 Chevrolet, operated by Shannon Jung, female, age 43, of Georgetown, OH was traveling westbound on I.R. 275 in the right lane of travel near milepost 68.2. As Ms. Jung slowed for traffic, she was struck from behind by a 2013 Hyundai operated by Jillian Winland, female, age 26, of Cincinnati, OH. The collision forced Ms. Jung's vehicle off the right side of the road. As it crossed the shoulder, Ms. Jung's vehicle struck Amy Steinmetz, female, age 28, of Batavia, OH. At the time of the crash, Ms. Steinmetz was walking along the right shoulder of westbound I.R. 275.

Neither Ms. Jung nor Ms. Winland was injured. Ms. Steinmetz was transported by the Anderson Township Fire Department to Anderson Mercy Hospital where she was pronounced dead.

Both Ms. Jung and Ms. Winland were wearing seatbelts at the time of the crash. Speed was not a factor in the crash. Alcohol and/or drugs were not factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit. Any witnesses to the crash are asked to contact the Traffic Safety Unit at (513) 825-1500.
