Greater Cincinnati Fusion Center analysts were able to identify the individual who posted the threatening information as Marvin Poindexter Gee. Through additional research it was discovered that the subject resided in Christian County, Kentucky. The Greater Cincinnati Fusion Center staff notified the Kentucky Intelligence Fusion Center and the Kentucky State Police of the threat.

Kentucky State Police were able to make contact with the individual and conclude that Gee made the threatening statement. Kentucky State Police arrested Gee and charged him with Solicitation for Murder of a Police Officer and his bond was set at \$500,000.00.

This is an excellent example of a collaborative effort with the Greater Cincinnati Fusion Center and the Fusion Center Network to disrupt a threat to the community and the nation.
